Subject: Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your **Tilaura Limestone Mine (193.252 Hect.)** in **Satna** district of **M.P. State.**

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by Shri Abhishek Ranjan Gautam, Assistant Mining Engineer on 09.11.2021 in presence of Shri. Saurabh Jain, Geologist and Shri Akhilesh Rai, Geologist as under:-

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.</p> <p>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/SATNA/LST/RMP-38/2019-20 dated 22.07.2020 incorporating the proposals of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It was proposed to produce 500000 metric tons of Limestone in the year 2020-21 but only 13942.940 tons production achieved and reported in Annual return. 2. It was proposed to remove 44000 cubic meter of Over Burden in the year 2020-21 but only 11792 cubic meter Over Burden removed as per office record. 3. It was proposed to remove 13200 cubic meter of Top Soil in the year 2020-21 but nil achieved. <p>The mine development was lagging from the approved proposal.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. As per annual return of 2020-21 plantations of 900 trees reported. But during inspection no new plantation observed. 5. Boundary pillars are not maintained properly as per rule.
Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</p> <p>Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2020-21).</p>

Rule 31(4)	<p>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case category 'B' mine</p> <p>The plans & sections are not found updated and maintained at mines site office.</p>
Rule 46	<p>The holder of the prospecting license or prospecting license cum mining lease or the mining lease shall,—</p> <p>when any new appointment of an agent, mining engineer, geologist or any person is made under sub-rule (1) of rule 55; or</p> <p>(b) when the employment of any such person is terminated or any such person leaves the said employment; or</p> <p>(c) when any change occurs in the address of any such person, within fifteen days from the date of such appointment, termination, leaving or change in address, give a notice in Form H of the Schedule to the authorised officer, as the case may be.</p> <p>During the inspection it was found mine Geologist and Mining engineer were appointed in the mine but intimation of their appointments were not sent to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection.</p>

01. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
02. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) and 35(4) of MCDR-2017.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.


