Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your Amehta Limestone Mine area 12.93 hect. in the Village-Amehta, Tehsil-Vijayraghgarh, District-Katni in Madhya Pradesh.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of mine representative Shri S K Jain on dated 14/06/2021 for the submitted draft review of mining plan. Following provisions of MCDR 2017, were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

Nature of violation observed in detail

Rule 44 Restoration of flora— Every holder of prospecting licence, prospecting license cum mining lease or a mining lease shall carry out prospecting or mining operations, as the case may be, in accordance with applicable laws and in such a manner so as to cause least damage to the flora of the area held under prospecting licence, prospecting license cum mining lease or mining lease and the nearby areas.

It is observed that the plantation is not carried out as per the approved proposals.

Rule 55 (1) (c) Every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category 'A' Mines, a whole time mining engineer and geologist.

Deployment of Geologist is not appointed in the mine; Therefore, employment of Geologist is to be done for the systematic and scientific mining operation accordance to the proposal submitted.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Fourty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
