Sub : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Dighori Kyanite Mine over an area of 14.33 hect in Bhandara district of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

During examination of office records of your Dighori Kyanite Mine over an area of 14.33 hect in Bhandara district, on 26/04/2013 by undersigned, it is observed that the following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules'1988 (MCDR'88), is violated in respect of your above referred mine.

Nature of Violation

13(1) Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme of mining as approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.

The mining operation are not carried out as per the approved to extent indicated below.

1. As per the mining plan approval letter No.BHD/KYA/MPLN-715 DATED 23/07/2012

Condition no 14 wherein it was stated that geo –referenced cadatral map should be submitted as per CCOM Circular 2/2010 within six month but you have failed to submit the same.

2. As per para 3.3 you have proposed to drill the one borehole during the 2012-13 but no borehole was drilled.

3. The mining lease is granted to you but Shri Vinod Bhujade is operating the through Power of attorney which violates the rule 38 of MCR 1960.

45(5) The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner, namely:-

a) a monthly return which shall be submitted before the 10<sup>th</sup> of every month in respect of preceding month in the Form as indicated below:-

(viii) for Limestone in Form F-8;

b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1<sup>st</sup> July each year for the preceding financial year in the form as indicated below:-

(viii) for Limestone in Form H-8;

If it is found that the owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of the mine has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in the monthly or special or annual return or fails to submit a return within the date specified, then the Regional Controller of Mines may,-

a) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and may revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;

b) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;

c) recommend termination of the mining lease in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining

***However, it is observed that, you have not submitted Monthly returns from April 2011 onwards and Annual returns for year 2011-12. Thus, you have failed in submitting monthly and annual returns within the date specified. These violations may lead to suspension of all mining operations in the mine as well as termination of mining lease and prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.***

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation of said rule constitutes an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR'88.
3. It was also brought to your notice that non compliance of these violations may lead to suspension of mining operations under rule 13(1) of MCDR 88.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 30 days from the date of issue of this letter.
