Subject: Violation of provision of MCDR 1988 in respect of your Yerekatte limestone mine (Area- 305.54Hect.), ML no. 2620, situated in Doddarampura & Chikkarampura villages, C.N Halli Taluk, Tumkur District of Karnataka state.

Sir,

The following provision of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 was found violated in your above mine during inspection on 19.06.2015 by the undersigned in presence of S/Shri P.Satya Saibaba- mines manager, Narayan Khannur- mining engineer & Manjunath Gajula- Geologist.

Rule	Nature of Violations observed
33(2)	Complete retention wall is not found constructed along the toe of Dump no. 1 (1600-1800 W, 1200-1400N) to prevent escape of material form the dump.

02. It is brought to your notice that violation of the above Rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 13(2), if compliance of rule 13(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office **within 45 (Forty Five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
