Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Larung limestone mine over an area of 4.76 Ha. in East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya state.

Sir,

On scrutiny of office records it has been observed that following rule of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 has been violated by you.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
27(2): Where financial assurance is required to be furnished by the holder of the mining lease under sub-rule (1), such amount of financial assurance shall be submitted to the authorised officer, as the case may be, in the form of a bank guarantee in the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines: Provided that where financial assurance has already been furnished before the commencement of these rules, an amount equal to the difference between the financial assurance due as on the date of notification of these rules and the financial assurance already furnished, shall be furnished to the authorised officer, as the case may be, within a period of ninety days from the date of notification of these rules:	The financial assurance in the form of BG i.r.o your Larung limestone mine was valid upto 31.3.2020. The extension of the bank guarantee for the further period beyond 1.4.2020 has not been submitted to this office.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.

05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard
