Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of your Kolugutla Yellow Ochre and Quartzite Mine over an extent of 15.185 ha in Kolugutla (v), Veldurthy (M) Kurnool District of Andhra Pradesh.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 29.5.2013 by Sri.M.Pratap Reddy, Assistant Mining Geologist of this office accompanied by your representative Sri Ramesh Geologist.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
12(3)	As per the records of this Office, the Mining Plan for your Kolugutla Yellow Ochre and Quartzite Mine was approved on 3.11.1988 and the proposed period of approved mining plan was from 1988 to 1993. A review of the Mining Plan for next five years falls due 120 days before end of the 1992-93. Thus for subsequent five years periods no Scheme of Mining/Mining Plan has been submitted to the competent authority, so far.
13(1)	Mining operations should be undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining. Since you have no approved Scheme of Mining/ Mining Plan for your above mentioned mine, it is evident that the mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved Scheme of Mining/Mining Plan.
23(F)	The Financial Assurance has to be furnished by every lease holder at the rate of rupees fifteen thousand for category B mine per hector of the mining lease area put to use for mining & allied activities with minimum amount of financial assurance for rupees one lakh but no such financial assurance has been submitted so far.

02. It is again brought to your notice that non compliance of the provisions of Rule 13(1) attracts provisions of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988(Amended), of MCDR, 1988 which leads to order of suspension of mining operations and these violations also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988.

03.You are, therefore, directed to **Show Cause** within a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence or the mining operations should not be suspended under rule 13(2) of MCDR,1988

04.Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
