Sub.- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR'88) in respect of your Prospecting License for Manganese Ore (5.36 Hect), in Village – Nandapuri, Tahsil – Mauda, District – Nagpur of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

This has reference to letter no PLV – N/475/2010/1906, dated-18.06.2010 from Directorate of Geology and Mining, Government of Maharashtra regarding above cited PL area granted to you. On examination of our office records and field inspection, following provisions of MCDR'88 were found violated in respect of the above PL.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
6	<p>Every holder of a prospecting licence shall carry out prospecting operations in accordance with the scheme of prospecting submitted under rule 4 or with such modification, if any.</p> <p>But as mentioned in the Form B seven no of pits have been dug instead of 4 no of pits. During inspection it was understood that 3 core boreholes has been drilled (cores are preserved) instead of 2 nos of non-core borehole as mentioned in the scheme of prospecting. This is a deviation from the Scheme of Prospecting submitted to this office, thus attracting violation of rule 6 of the MCDR'88.</p>
8(1)	<p>Every holder of a prospecting licence shall submit to the Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller, an yearly report in Form-B so as to reach them within thirty (30) days after the expiry of twelve months from the date of execution of the prospecting licence or the expiry of the prospecting licence whichever is earlier, and a final report in Form-B within a period of three (3) months after the completion of the prospecting operations or the expiry of the prospecting licence whichever is earlier.</p> <p>One yearly report in Form-B has been received in this but the final report in Form-B has also not been received in this office within a period of three (3) months after the expiry of the prospecting licence, thus attracting violation of rule 8 of the MCDR'88.</p>
47	<p>The owner, agent, mining engineer, geologist or manager of every mine or the holder of a prospecting licence shall send intimation in Form J to the Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller of Mines with in fifteen days after the commencement of the sinking of trial shaft or borehole to a depth exceeding ten meters from the surface.</p>

But during PL inspection on 19.7.2013, it is observed that three nos of core borehole has been drilled upto 30 mts, 35 mts and 20 mts depth respectively (the core samples are also preserved), but no intimation in Form J has been received, thus attracting violation of rule 47 of the MCDR'88.

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 58 of the MCDR'88.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
