Subject : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and development Rules, 1988 in respect of your **Dhaurabhata Dolomite Mine** over an area of 3.087 Hect. in Bilaspur district of Chhattisgarh State.

Sir,

During the inspection of your mine on 23.08.2013 by the undersigned, violation of provisions of Rule 13(1) of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 amended vide notification of GSR 75(E) dated 09.02.2011, was observed and the same was communicated to you vide above referred letter (ref no 1).

However, the reply furnished by you in this regard as referred above (ref no 2), has been considered by this office but found unsatisfactory against the second observation i.e., bench height was more than 6.0 m as proposed in the modified mining Plan, and, it was observed even more than 10.0 m at places. In your reply you've written that present benches all along the lease boundary are the ultimate pit limit, hence pit slope will be maintained by proper benching, but as the ultimate pit limit has been reached, how far it is possible to maintain proper and systematic bench height norms.

For the purpose, you are directed to submit a schematic and systematic program to achieve height of the benches under permissible limits.

In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violation of said rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

You are, therefore, **show cause within a period of 30 (thirty) days** from the date of issue of this notice, as to why mining operations in your above mine should not be suspended in accordance to rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 and the lease is recommended for termination as well as prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.

Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
