**Subject** : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 in respect of your **Manegaon Iron Ore Mine** over an area of 4.04 Hect. in Gondia district of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

On examination of this office records and as per the inspection of your mines on 31.07.2013 by the undersigned, it is observed that the following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 amended vide notification of GSR 75(E) dated 09.02.2011 are violated in respect of your above referred mine.

<b>Rule</b>	<b>Nature of violations observed</b>
13(1)	<p>Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved Mining Plan / Scheme of Mining with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the Mining Plan or Scheme of Mining approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.</p> <p><i>As per the approved Mining Plan, approved vide letter No. GND/Fe/MPLN-886/NGP, dated 30/06/2005, in 2008-09 proposed production was 5014 T of iron ore (float &amp; in-situ) but actual production from the mine was 9263.97 T i.e., around 85% more than the proposed production in the Mining Plan.</i></p>
42(1)	<p>For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules:</p> <p>(c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of:-</p> <p>(ii) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist.</p> <p><i>But in the mine there is no mining engineer or geologist appointed.</i></p> <p><i>Thus, you have violated rule 13(1) and 42(1) of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988. The violation of rule 13(1) of MCDR'88, may lead to suspension of mining operations in accordance to rule 13(2) of the MCDR'88.</i></p>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violation of said rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore **directed to show-cause within a period of 30 days** from the date of issue of this letter, as to why mining operations in your above mine should not be suspended in accordance to rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 and the lease is recommended for termination as well as prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
