Subject : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 in respect of your **Manegaon Iron Ore Mine** over an area of 4.04 Hect. in Gondia district of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

On examination of this office records and as per the inspection of your mines on 31.07.2013 by the undersigned, it is observed that the following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988 amended vide notification of GSR 75(E) dated 09.02.2011 are violated in respect of your above referred mine.

Rule	Nature of violations observed
45(5)	The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner, namely:- b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1 st July each year for the preceding financial year in the Form as indicated below:- (i) for Iron ore in Form H-1;
45(7)	If it is found that the owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of the mine has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in the monthly or special or annual return or fails to submit a return within the date specified, then the Regional Controller of Mines may,- a) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and may revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; b) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules; c) recommend termination of the mining lease in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining <i>However, in the annual return for the year 2012-2013 in Form H-1, following errors have been observed:</i> <i>Part-I</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <i>Registration no. allotted by IBM is not mentioned.</i>2. <i>Under item no 3, correct address should be mentioned .</i>3. <i>Under item no 12, total area utilized is not matching with the sum of the area</i>

distributed for various usage.

Part-II

- 1. In the tables under the header 'Employment and Wages', some of the fields are kept blank.*
- 2. In the item 3(i), incorrect information is provided.*
- 3. In the tables under the header 'Capital structure', all the fields are kept blank.*

Part-III

- 1. Table given under item (1) is blank.*

Part-IV

- 1. Total production and overburden removed are not mentioned.*

Part-V

- 1. Type of the ore to be mentioned.*
- 2. Chemical Analysis of typical grade produced is not given.*
- 3. Under item 3, resources/reserves mentioned are as in 2008 and to be updated as on 31.03.2013.*
- 4. Under item 4.2, in the details of workings, number of benches, average height & depth of deepest working are not mentioned. Also production and waste removed during the year is not mentioned under item B & C.*
- 5. Under 6(i), detail of future plans for exploration is not mentioned*
- 6. Up to date plans and sections as required under Rule 28 of MCDR is not submitted.*

Part-VI

- 1. Mineral is not mentioned under item no 1.*
- 2. Ex-mine price/ PMV is not mentioned.*
- 3. Details of Fines generated is not given.*
- 4. Table given under item (4) is kept blank.*
- 5. In the nature of dispatch, captive use is mentioned whereas the ore is being sold to outside parties and also no details have been given for captive plant.*
- 6. In the table given under the details of 'Sales/dispatches', Registration no of the consignee allotted by IBM. Also sale value needs to be mentioned.*

Thus, you have violated rule 45(5) and 45(7) of Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 1988. These violations lead to suspension of all mining operations in the mine as well as termination of mining lease and prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violation of said rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 58 of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, **directed to show-cause within a period of 30 days** from the date of issue of this letter, as to why mining operations in your above mine should not be suspended in accordance to rule 45(7) of MCDR, 1988.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
