Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Jhabua Rock Phosphate mining lease over an extent of 37.7 hect in district Jhabua of Madhya Pradesh.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the undersigned along with P. Nahar (AMG) on 02.06.2018 in presence of Shri S.K Dwivedi (Mines Manager), Shri Burhanuddin Dalal (Assistant Manager), Shri Ramesh Bhumarkar (Dy GM Mechanical).

26(2)	<p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation reason thereof:</p> <p><i>The yearly report for the year 2015-16 & 2016-17 have not been submitted to the competent authority by the holder of the lease in the prescribed in this office till date.</i></p>
33	<p>The holder of mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.</p> <p><i>The surface geological plan to be submitted on or before the 30.6.2017 has not been received at this office till date.</i></p>
45(5) (c)	<p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller of Mines on any other authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of the Indian Bureau of Mines, in the following manner, namely:-</p> <p>(c) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the Preceding financial year in the electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form.</p> <p><i>During the inspection it was observed that mineralized dumps/stacks (apart from the grade wise stock) are existing in the lease area which have not been reported in the submitted annual returns.</i></p>

(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules,—

3. every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of—

(iii) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;

(iv) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

Provided that in the case of fully mechanized category 'A' mines, the mining engineer and geologist shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining:

The Review of Mining plan of Jhabua Rock phosphate Mining lease was approved on 11.06.2013 under Category 'A'. During inspection it was observed that the appointment of full time Geologist has not been done for the Jhabua Rock phosphate mining lease.

01. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017.
02. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
03. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
