Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Laupada Iron Ore Mine over an area of 80.536 hectare in Keonjar District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (hereinafter referred MCDR,1988) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 20.04.2015 by undersigned accompanied by Shri Tushar Bhowmick (Lessee representative), Sri K.N. Routray (Mining Officer, Keonjhar) and Shri S.C Nayak (RQP, Minesketch Consultants Pvt. Ltd.) and communicated to you vide this office letter of even number dated 26.05.2015 giving you a period of 45 (Forty-five) days for rectification of same.

Rule	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.	1) As per the condition mentioned at Sl no. xiv in the approval letter of the Modification of approved Mining Plan along with mine closer plan dated 20.11.2014, the lessee should submit a yearly report as per Rule 23E(2) of MCDR' 1988 to the regional controller of mines . Till date no such report has been submitted, resulting violation to the approval of Modification of approved Mining Plan.
23(E)(2)	The owner, agent, manager or mining engineer shall submit to the regional Controller of Mines.....if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.	1) The yearly report on extent of protective and rehabilitation works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closer plan for year 2013-14 has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Bhubaneswar till date.
45(5)(b)	An annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st July each year for the preceding financial year in the Form as indicated below:- (i) for Iron ore in Form H-1	1) The Annual return in form H-1 has not submitted to the office of Regional Controller of Mines, IBM Bhubaneswar for the year 2013-14.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that no reply has yet been received in this office; in respect of this office letter of even number dated 26.05.2015.

03. Further, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of rule 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.
04. You are therefor directed to show-cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter as why you should not be prosecuted for the above violation and or the mining operation shall be suspended under rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.
05. Please not that no further time will be given to you in this regard.
