Subject: Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your **Chandan Limestone Mine (5.605 Hect.)** in **Katni** district of **M.P. State**.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by Shri Abhishek Ranjan Gautam, Assistant Mining Engineer on 20.07.2021 in presence of Shri. R K Mishra, Manager as under:-

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.</p> <p>The modification of approved Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Katni/LST/MPLN/MOD-46/2017-18 dated 16.05.2017 incorporating the proposals of working from 2017-18 to 2021-22. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Exploration is not carried out against proposal of 04 exploratory bore holes and 08 numbers of trenches with the dimension of (40-30mX3mX2-3m) during the year 2017-18.2. As per proposal, Backfilling was not done within 7.5m barrier zone between Pillar no 7 to 8 of the lease area.3. Boundary pillars are not maintained properly as per CCOM circular no 1/2010.4. Plantation was not done against the proposal of 40 plants during the approved proposal period.
Rule 26(2)	<p><i>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</i></p> <p>Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2020-21).</p>
Rule 31(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case category 'B' mine</i></p> <p>The plans & sections were not found updated and maintained at mines site office.</p>



Rule 35(2)	<p>Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining & allied activities as per the notified template of Star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the first day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy of high resolution satellite images from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map under provision of rule".</p> <p>The Star Ratings Templates for the year 2020-21 is not submitted.</p>
Rule 55	<p>Employment of geologists and mining engineers. -(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, -</p> <p>(a) every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist;</p> <p>(b) every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer;</p> <p>(c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of-</p> <p>(i) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;</p> <p>(b) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:</p> <p>Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining:</p> <p>Mining Engineer and Geologist have not been appointed.</p>

01. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
02. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) & 35(2) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) and 35(4) of MCDR-2017.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.




