Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Bhatgawan Sunehra Limestone Mine over an area of 4.13 hect. in Katni District of M.P.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 20.07.2021 by Sh. Jay Kumar Pandey, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by Sh. S.K. Garg, representative of lessee & Sh. Ajay Kumar Pandey, Mining Engineer.

Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Katni/Limestone /RMP-25/2019-20 dated 20/12/2019 incorporating proposal of working from 2019-20 to 2021-22. Exploration was not done against the proposal of 05 nos. of exploratory bore holes for 2019-20.
Rule 29	Intimation of reopening of a mine.—The holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government an intimation in Form C of the Schedule of reopening of a mine after temporary discontinuance, so as to reach them within fifteen days from the date of such reopening. The mining operations was discontinued from 01/04/2018 and reopened from June 2020 but reopening notice not sent to this office.
Rule 33	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.
Rule 46	The holder of the prospecting licence or prospecting license cum mining lease or the mining lease shall,—when any new appointment of an agent, mining engineer, geologist or any person is made under sub-rule (1) of rule 55; or (b) when the employment of any such person is terminated or any such person leaves the said employment; or (c) when any change occurs in the address of any such person, within fifteen days from the date of such appointment, termination, leaving or change in address, give a notice in Form H of the Schedule to the authorised officer, as the case may be. Shri Sridhar Pandey, as Part time Geologist and Shri Ajay kumar Pandey as Mining engineer were appointed from March 2021 & October 2020 but intimation of their appointments was not sent to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection. Also earlier appointed part time geologist Sh. Ramraj Kushwaha resigned but their termination notice in Form H not sent to this office.
