Sub. : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Jagantola Mn Ore Mine (6.264 Ha), Mine code – 40MPR01027 at Village Jagantola, Tehsil-Paraswada, District- Balaghat (M.P.).

Sir/Madam,

This is in continuation to the previous violation letter dated 08.07.2021. Undersigned has inspected your mine in your presence along with Shri Mahesh Choudhry (Mine Geologist) and Shri Shalabh Saha (Qualified Person) on 17/06/2021. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection:

Rule No.	Nature of violation observed in detail
<b>Rule 11(1)</b>	(i) Only 5088.610 tonnes of ROM is achieved against the proposal of 13860 tonnes. (ii) Only 600 m <sup>3</sup> of mineral rejects generated against the proposal of 1109 m <sup>3</sup> .
<b>Rule 26(2)</b>	Yearly report in respect of protective and rehabilitative works carried out has not been submitted for the year 2019-20 & 2020-21.
<b>45(7)</b>	Following discrepancy was observed in the Annual Returns submitted for the year 2020-21. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Part-I: In Sl.No.08 Information in respect of Mining Engineer is furnished incorrectly. In Sl.No.12, the lease area (surface area) utilisation are furnished incorrectly.</li> <li>ii. Part-II A Capital Structure: The value of fixed assets is mentioned as nil.</li> <li>iii. Part – V, Reserves and Resources estimated at the end of the year for Manganese ore were incorrectly submitted.</li> <li>iv. Part -VII In the cost per tonne calculation, the details of DMF and NMET are not included.</li> <li>v. Also the details of taxes are not matching with the amount submitted in the Part-III, Sl.No.5.</li> <li>vi. Depreciation cost considered for the cost per tonne calculation in Part-VII are not matching with the depreciation details furnished in Part-II A &amp; Part-III Sl.No.4.</li> </ol>

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
