Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of the Nandavaram Limestone Mine of Sri M.Narayan reddy over an extent of 1.174 ha in Nandavaram village,Banganapalli Mandal,Kurnool district,Andhra Pradesh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988, were found violated in the above mine during inspection on 24.04.2016 by Shri A.V.Ramesh Kumar, Assistant Mining Geologist.,of this office accompanied by your representative Sri Narsi Reddy.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be. Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/ Scheme of Mining. The Mining Plan was approved on 11.04.2003 and the lease was executed on 07.01.2004.The validity of the proposals in the approved Mining Plan have expired on 31.03.2009.No scheme of mining was submitted for the subsequent five year period.Since there is no approved document for the above mentioned Mine, it is evident that the Mining Operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved document.

02. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13(1), is also liable for suspension of mining operations under rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, directed to **show-cause** within a period of 30(thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be **prosecuted** for the above offence and or Mining operations shall be suspended under the provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR,1988 in the Mine till the compliance of the aforesaid violation.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
