Sir,

The following provisions of the MCDR, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the MCDR inspection by Sri A.S.Sanjeeva Rao, Asst., Mining Geologist on 28.12.2015 in presence of your representative Sri M.Muthukaruppan.

Rule No	Nature of Violations observed
13(1)	It was proposed in the approved scheme of mining to produce 7144 tonnes of limestone during the year 2014-15 and 8836 tonnes for the year 2015-16, whereas actual production was 43010 tonnes and 25450 tonnes as reported in the annual return for the year 2014-15 and review of the Scheme of Mining for the current year 2015-16.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 58 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 1988.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
