**Subject:** Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your **Vikram Limestone Mine-IV, (52.353 Hect.)** Mine code **38MPR51005** in **Neemuch** district of **M.P. State**.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during inspection on 11/08/2022 by the undersigned in presence of Shri Subhash Chandra Nigam, Agent Mines, Shri Mahesh Chandra Shrimali, Mine Manager & Shri Ratikanta Behera, Geologist.

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of</p> <p>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No- MP/NEEMUCH/LIMESTONE/MPLN/G-19/2017-18 dated 08.08.2017 incorporating the proposals of working from 2018-19 to 2022-23. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated</p> <p><b>1. It was proposed to produce 100000 Metric tons of Limestone in the year 2021-22 but only 46859 Metric tons production achieved.</b></p>
Rule 28 (1)	<p><b>Subject to the provisions of section 4A, the holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government a notice in Form E when the mining or mineral processing operations in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them within one hundred and twenty days from the date of such temporary discontinuance.</b></p> <p>During inspection &amp; the scrutiny of office records, it has been observed that mining operations in the mine are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days (from 26/03/2022 to 13/07/2022) and intimation in Form E in respect of discontinuance of mining operations has not been submitted to this office till date of inspection.</p>

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
03. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) & of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
