Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your New Satuk Manganese Ore Mine over an area of 16.84 Hect. situated in District-Nagpur of Maharashtra state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation Development Rules, 2017 are found violated in respect of your above referred mine during the inspection on 10.06.2021 carried out by the undersigned alongwith Shri. Snehankit Chatte, Asst. Mining Engineer:-

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>In this connection following deficiencies are observed during the inspection of your above referred mine:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. As per the Mining Plan approved on 10.07.2020, it was proposed to drill 02 (two) nos. of boreholes during the year 2020-21 but at the time of inspection no borehole were drilled.</li><li>2. It was proposed to develop a decline of 3m X 5m from 276 MRL from surface &amp; ends at 247 MRL &amp; Winze of 2m X 2m for 30m depth in the underground but the same was not found during inspection.</li><li>3. The proposals were given to reclaim the old pit year wise in 0.54 hect area, but during the inspection, no such activity was seen.</li><li>4. Further, the production was proposed for the year 2020-21 was 1750 T during the underground development but after examination of Monthly/ Annual Returns during the inspection, it is observed that the mine has produced 3523 T (approx.) from Dump mining. No proposals for Dump Mining were furnished in the mining plan approved on 10.07.2020.</li></ol> <p>Thus there is deviation from the approved Mining plan document dated 10.07.2020.</p> <p><i>These violations may leads to suspension of all mining operations in the mine as well as termination of mining lease and prosecution of the Owner, Agent and Manager.</i></p>

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operation can be suspended by the competent authority and suitable actions can be initiated under Rule 11(2), if compliance is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised **to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
