Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Wanjri Limestone Mines over an area of 8.863 Hect. situated in Village- Wanjri, District- Yawatmal of Maharashtra state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation Development Rules, 2017 are found violated in respect of your above referred mine during the inspection on 30.08.2021 carried out by Shri. Snehankit Chatte, Asst. Mining Engineer alongwith Shri. N.N. Warwatkar, Owner & Shri. M.D. Khuspure, Manager (Mines):-

For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules,-

(c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of-

(i) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;

(ii) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

As per this office records, the notice of appointment of Mining Engineer & Geologist has not been received in this office.

In view of above, it is appeared that, the mining operations are being carried out without Mining Engineer & Geologist.

This attracts the violation of provisions of Rule 55(1)(c) of Mineral Conservation Development Rules, 2017.

*These violations may leads to suspension of all mining operations under Rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017.*

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that, the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operation can be suspended by the competent authority and suitable actions can be initiated under Rule 11(2), if compliance is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised **to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
