Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Jamuanikala Limestone mine over an extent of 31.43 hect in district Katni of Madhya Pradesh.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 4.10.2018 in presence of Shri Manish Upadhyia (Deputy General Manager), Rajnikanta Sahani(Mines Manager).

| 11(1) | <p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p><i>The modification in the approved mining plan of the Jamuanikala limestone over an area of 31.43 hect was approved on 4.4.2016 vide letter number MP/Katni/Limestone/MPLN/MOD-27/2015-16 for the financial year 2016-17 to 2020-21. As per approved proposals for the year 2018-19 the development of mineral benches was to be done due north and due west of the existing pit. During the inspection it was observed that the development of overburden benches due north is lagging behind the approved proposals for the year 2018-19 leading to blocking of mineral benches at 379.5 MRL, 372 MRL.</i></p> |
| 26(2) | <p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation reason thereof:</p> <p><i>The yearly report for the year 2017-18 have not been submitted to the competent authority by the holder the lease at this office till date.</i></p> |
| 33 | <p>The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.</p> <p><i>The plans and section have not been submitted at the office till date.</i></p> |
