Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Bhatara Limestone Mine over an area of 2.748 hect. in Satna District of M.P.

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 08.10.2021 by Sh. Jay Kumar Pandey, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by Sh. P.D. Awasthi, lessee.

| Rule 11(1) | <p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Satna/Limestone /RMP-70/2017-18 dated 05/01/2018 incorporating proposal of working from 2018-19 to 2022-23.</p> <p>(a) In the year 2020-21 the development proposed for removal of 4944 cu.m. of Top soil/soil but in actual no such development/removal of soil done during the year 2020-21.</p> <p>(b) In the year 2020-21 the backfilling was proposed in Eastern side of lease area between pillar no.13 & 14 but in actual backfilling was done in northern side backfilled area against proposed site during the year 2020-21 as observed during inspection.</p> |
| Rule 26(2) | <p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.</p> <p>Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2020-21).</p> |
| Rule 33 | <p>Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.</p> |

| Rule 55 | <p>For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, –</p> <p>(a) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of–</p> <p>(i) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;</p> <p>(ii) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:</p> <p>Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining.</p> <p>The Mining Engineer & Geologist have not been appointed in the mine.</p> |

3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.




