Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your Gosalpur Mn and Iron Ore Mine over an area of 12.77 hect. in Jabalpur district of M.P.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of QP Shri I Dawande on dated 25/03/2019, for submitted draft Review of Mining Plan, following provisions of MCDR 2017, were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail

Rule 11 (1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.

The Modification of Mining Plan of the above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/JBP/Manganese Ore/M.Sch/Modi-01/14-15 dated 22/06/2015, incorporating proposals from year 2015-16 to 2018-19. During the inspection it was observed that mining operations in the mine was not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the approved Modification of Mining Plan. The extents of deviation observed during inspection are as under:

In approved Document in page no 09, it was proposed to drill total 12 nos of boreholes up to the depth of 50 m each (in year 2015-16) at the grid interval of 100-150m. During the inspection it was observed that above mentioned proposal was not carried out. As per proposal given in the modification of mining plan no development and production were done in the lease area.

Rule 28 (1) Subject to the provisions of section 4A, the holder of a mining lease shall send to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government a notice in Form E when the mining or mineral processing operations in the mine or part thereof are discontinued for a period exceeding ninety days so as to reach them within one hundred and twenty days from the date of such temporary discontinuance.

As per the inspection and office records it's been observed that notice of temporary discontinuance for the mine has not been submitted in this office. You are advised to furnish the notice of temporary discontinuance to this office in prescribed format as per MCDR 2017.

Rule 55 (1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, –

every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist;

every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer;

every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of–

category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;

category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining. Information of Mining Engineer and Geologist appointed are to be provided to this office in the prescribed form.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.

4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
