Sub:- Violation letter of your NawargaonChowaKyanite Mine of M/s, Maharashtra State Mining Corporation Ltd., over an area of 40.61 Hectares situated near village – NawargaonChowaTeh- Bhandara, District- Bhandara of Maharashtra State in connection with Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found violated in respect of the above said mine during inspection on 17.09-2021 by A.K.PatelAMG.along with Shri SonpipreGeologist M/s MSMC Ltd. Shri Sonpipre & Shri UttamKharabe Mines Manager.

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part-B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The following deviations were observed in the approved Mining Plan dated BHD/KYA/MPLN-896/NAG-2017 Dated 13/X/2017. (1) Production is not done as per the approved mining plan as per the target, for the five years:-

35(2)	Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the 1 st day of July every year for the previous financial year, alongwith the soft copy (in the standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31st day of March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometers. from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines. Star rating template is not submitted.										
55.(c) (i)	Category 'A' mines whole time mining engineer and geologist (ii) category 'B' mines whole time mining engineer and Geologist, For the purpose of caring out mining operation, Geologist and mining engineer is required.										

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2), if compliance of MCD Rules 2017 is not found satisfactory, or prosecution can be made, or both can be done.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
