**Subject:** Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Kachagawan Limestone Mine over an area of 3.456 hect. in Katni District of M.P.


Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 18.11.2021 by Sh. Jay Kumar Pandey, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by Sh. G.D.Dixit, representative of lessee.

नियम स.	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
<b>Rule 11(1)</b>	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Katni/Limestone /RMP-57/2019-20 dated 30/06/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2024-25. <b>(a) Exploration was not done against the proposal of 02 nos. of exploratory Core bore holes for the year 2020-21.</b>
<b>Rule 26(2)</b>	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 <sup>st</sup> day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof. <b>Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2020-21).</b>
<b>Rule 33</b>	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. <b>Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.</b>
<b>Rule 46</b>	The holder of the prospecting licence or prospecting license cum mining lease or the mining lease shall,—when any new appointment of an agent, mining engineer, geologist or any person is made under sub-rule (1) of rule 55; or (b) when the employment of any such person is terminated or any such person leaves the said employment; or (c) when any change occurs in the address of any such person, within fifteen days from the date of such appointment, termination, leaving or change in address, give a notice in Form H of the Schedule to the authorised officer, as the case may be. <b>Shri L.P.Chaturvedi as Mining engineer, Diploma in mining &amp; mine surveying with FCC certificate and Shri Ajay Pandey, M.Sc. (Geology) as Part time Geologist were appointed from July 2021 &amp; November 2021 respectively but intimation of their appointments was not sent to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection.</b>

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
