**Subject:** Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Rajarwara limestone Mine (4.28 Ha), Mine code -38MPR47129 in Katni District of (M.P.).  
Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of Shri Ranjan Grover (Lessee's Representative) and Shri Manoj Roy (Mines Head) on 13/09/2021. The following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mine during inspection:

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No boreholes drilled against the proposal of 03 core boreholes during the year 2020-21.</li><li>• Refer the approved document, it was proposed to provide a garland drain around the pit to prevent inrush of rainwater into the mining pit. But it was observed during inspection that the garland drain provided around the pit was not maintained properly. Hence, the mine was flooded till date of inspection.</li></ul>
26(2)	Yearly PMCP report has not been submitted for the year 2020-21.
35(2)	Star rating self-assessment report has not been submitted for the Assessment year 2020-21.
45(7)	Annual Return for the year 2020-21 was not submitted.


1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
