Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Sitapuri Limestone Mine over an extent of 965 hect. in Dhar District of M.P.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of Mines officials Shri Subash Chandra Nigam on 17/07/2019. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

The Review of Mining Plan for above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/Dhar/Limestone/RMP-38/2018-19, dated 26/12/2018 incorporating proposals from 2019-20 to 2023-24. During the inspection it was observed that mining operations in the mine was not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the approved Review of Mining Plan. The extents of deviation observed during the inspection are as under:

**Rule 11(1)** No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.

- In the approved mining plan, it was proposed to prepare a sump of 50m X 50m X 4m dimension, in the south of the area. Which is not prepared as per the proposal given.

**Rule 26 (2)** The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan.

- However, yearly report of protective and rehabilitative works carried out during 2018-19, were not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, within stipulated time frame and till the date of inspection.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
