Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to **Ghandhigram Ochre, laterite & Iron Ore Mine** (Mine Code 44MPR18002) over an extent of 9.47 hectares situated in village Ghandhigram Village, Jabalpur District of Madhya Pradesh State

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by the undersigned on 05/11/2024 in presence of Shri B.K Bhargava (Lessee Representative), Shri. Sushil Kumar Bajpai (Qualified Person).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
Rule 11(1).	<p><i>Mining operations under mining lease.-(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: -</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Laterite and Ochre production reported as nil against the proposed quantities of 2350Cu.m and 28200 Cu.m respectively. It is observed that Mine working have been encroached the 7.5m barrier in between the boundary pillars No. BP 19 to BP 19/5 and BP 5/2 to BP6/4. Bench heights are not maintaining systematically which resulting creation of high wall on eastern side. Only 13 Bore holes drilled against the 16 boreholes proposed in the last approved document.
	<p><i>If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then, -</i></p>

Rule 45(7)	<p><i>(a) in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines or the authorized officer of the State Government may -Order suspension of all mining operations and dispatches in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;</i></p> <p>Refer PART-I Upload Document</p> <p>The attached Kml/Kmz file should contain the lease boundary, polygon representing the reporting year development and cumulative land use details whereas only lease boundary details are depicted.</p> <p>Refer PART-I Lease area utilisation.</p> <p>The details furnished are incorrect and to be in line with the features depicted in attached kml as well as the UAV data submitted in DDMS portal.</p> <p>Refer Part V S.No 02:</p> <p>The details of Reserves available as on 31.03.2024 are not matching with the Reserves furnished last approved Review of Mining Plan and subsequent production achievement reported.</p>

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017 and that non-compliance of rule 12 (4) shall be punishable with fine of Rs 5,00,000/-.
3. Non-compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017 may lead to suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 days from the date of issue of this letter.
