Subject:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Malanjkhanda Copper Mine, over an area of 479.9 hectare, situated in village Malanjkhanda, Tehsil- Baihar, District-Balaghat of Madhya Pradesh State.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of your representative Shri V.N Mishra (Geologist), Shri KD Babu (AGM –Mines) and Sunish Raj (Manager –Geology) on 24/09/2024. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

11(1)of MCDR 2017	<p>1. Mining operations under mining lease.–(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2)</p> <p>The Modification of Mining Plan for above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. E 12438 MCDR-MPC0Cu/2/2024-JBP-IBM_RO_JBP dated 23/01/2025 incorporating proposal of working from 2024-25 to 2027-28.</p> <p>During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> It was proposed to produce 2475295 Tonnes of ROM, but 2545820 T of ROM production is done. Hence Excess production is done.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
- Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard..
