विषय: गुजरात राज्य के जिले- पोरबंदर की तालुका- रानावाव में स्थित आपकी रानावाव चूनापत्थर खान, क्षेत्रफल- 2 हे. में खनिज संरक्षण एवं विकास नियमावली, 2017 के नियमों का उल्लंघन।

महोदय,

आपकी उपरोक्त खान का स्टार रेटिंग निरीक्षण अधोहस्ताक्षरी द्वारा दिनांक 17-10-2024 को श्री श्री कानाभाई गोगनभाई भूतिया (खान मालिक) तथा श्री विशाल पटेल (भूविज्ञानी) की उपस्थिति में किया गया तथा उक्त निरीक्षण के समय खनिज संरक्षण एवं विकास नियमावली, 2017 के निम्नलिखित नियमों का उल्लंघन पाया गया-

26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July report every year 1[along with annual return] setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof: However in your case it is found that report on PMCP work has not been submitted along with Annual Return.
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32 along with the annual return. However in your case it is found that no Plan and Section have been submitted along with Annual Return.
34(A)	In the Drone data Images submitted under Rule 34(A), it is observed that the processed Drone survey output data submitted to Indian Bureau of Mines is not as per the SOP issued in this regard. The deviations in the drone data submitted is as follows:- No permanent GCPs were found at Mine.
45(5)(c) read with 45(7)	The following deficiencies have been found in the scrutiny of the annual return submitted by you for the year 2023-24 – 1. At the time of inspection plantation done in and around mine is shown however it is not reported in PART-V (General Geology & Mining) at point 5 (Trees planted- survival rate) of Annual Return.

Reserves given in Annual Return 2023-24 in PART-V (General Geology & Mining) at point number 2 Reserves and Resources estimated (in tonnes) (LIMESTONE) are not matching with Approved Mining Plan MCDR-MPCP0CaFl/33/2023-GNRIBM_RO_GNR MP-499 dated 26-09-2023. In Annual Return 2023-24 total resources are reported as 453,384.00 T, however in Mining Plan it is shown as 492280.76 T.</p> <p>3. In PART-VI (PRODUCTION, DESPATCHES AND STOCKS) (LIMESTONE) at point No 3(ii) Grade-wise Production, Dispatches, Stocks and Ex-mine prices, production and dispatch of dispatch of 10 T of cement Grade limestone has been reported. However no Royalty is shown in PART-III (Consumption of Materials) at point 2 Royalty, Rents and Payments made to DMF and NMET (₹).</p>

1. In this connection, it is brought to your kind notice that :-
 - a) the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 and/or;
 - b) Mining operations can be suspended as per rule 11(2) of MCDR 2017 in case of non-compliance of above rules as these violations also affects provisions of Rule11(1) of MCDR 2017 and/or;
 - c) You are advised to rectify the above violation of above Rules immediately and intimate the compliance position to this office, within a period of 45 days for violated rules from date of issue of this letter.
2. In case of violation of Rule 34(A), you are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and upload data online on DDMS portal **within 45 (Forty Five) days** from the date of issue of this letter
3. In case of violation of Rule 45,
 - a) You are also liable to pay such amount as prescribed under MCDR 2017 for delay of each day as per **Schedule-II**, read with Rule **45(7A)** in case of non-compliance of various provisions of Rule 45.
 - b) As per provision of Rule **45(7) and/or45(7A)(ii)** the Regional Controller of Mines may take appropriate action including order of suspension of **all mining operations and dispatches** on non-compliance of various provisions of Rule 45.
4. In context to the violations of Rule 45, this letter has been considered as show cause notice where you are advised to rectify above violation immediately. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of **30 days** for violations of Rule 45 from the date of issue of this letter as to why the action under Rules **45(7) and/or 45(7A)** shall not be taken against you. No further notice will be given to you in this regard.
5. This letter is being issued with the approval of Regional Controller of Mines.
