विषय: गुजरात राज्य के जूनागढ़ जिले की मलिया(हटिना) तालुका में स्थित आपकी Khorasa Limestone Mine क्षेत्रफल- 4 Ha हे. में खनिज संरक्षण एवं विकास नियमावली, 2017 के नियमों का उल्लंघन।
महोदय,

आपकी उपरोक्त खान का स्टार रेटिंग निरीक्षण अधोहस्ताक्षरी द्वारा Virtual Inspection किया गया था। उक्त निरीक्षण के समय खनिज संरक्षण एवं विकास नियमावली, 2017 के निम्नलिखित नियमों का उल्लंघन पाया गया-

Rule No.	Nature of Violation observed
45(5)(c) read with 45(7)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online Annual returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines which shall be submitted before 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, which shall be complete, correct and true in all aspects. However, in your case, it is found that; a) You have submitted following incomplete/ wrong/ false information in the Annual Return for the year 2023-24:- i) In PART-I (General), section-12 (Lease area (surface area) utilisation as at the end of Year), lease area utilization details not reported in Annual Return (A.R) 2023-24. ii) In PART-I (General), (Uploaded documents), PMCP yearly report and UAV Survey (KML/KMZ) file not attached with A.R. 2023-24.
34(A)	Every lessee having— (a) an annual excavation plan of one million tonne or more in a particular year; or (b) leased area of fifty hectare or more, shall carry out a drone survey of the leased area and upto hundred metres outside the lease boundary in the month of April or May every year and submit the processed output [digital elevation model (DEM) and Orthomosaic] images obtained from such survey or any other format as may be specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines in this regard to the Controller General on or before 1st day of July every year. However, in your case, it is found that; The drone survey data you submitted on the DDMS portal of the Indian Bureau of Mines does not comply with the SOP under Rule 34(A). The discrepancies in your submitted data include the absence of Permanent GCPs and the shape file indicating afforestation and green belt development locations.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your kind notice that;

- (1) As per provision of Rule 45(7), on non-compliance of various provisions of Rule 45(5) of MCDR, 2017, The Regional Controller of Mines may take following actions;
 - a) Order suspension of all mining operations and dispatches in the mine;
 - b) Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;
 - c) Recommend termination of the mining lease in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining.
 - (2) As per provisions of Rule 45(7A)(ii)(a) of MCDR 2017, which stipulates that the mining lease holder shall rectify the violation stated in the show cause notice and deposit within the period of thirty days, such amount as specified in Schedule II for the period from due date of submission of return till the date of rectification of violation.
 - (3) As per provisions of Rule 45(7A)(ii)(b) of MCDR 2017, if the mining lease holder does not provide satisfactory reply or rectify the violation within the said period of thirty days, the mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and any action under sub-rule (7) of Rule 45 may be initiated.
 - (4) The above violations also constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62(1) of MCDR 2017.
3. You are advised to rectify the aforesaid violations pointed out immediately and intimate the compliance position to this office within the period of 30 days from the date of issue of this Show Cause Notice.
 4. Therefore in context to above and as per provision of Rule 45(7A)(i) you are hereby directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter as to why the action under rule 45(7) and/or 45(7A)(ii)(b) shall not be taken against you.
 5. In case of violation of Rule 34(A), you are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and upload data online on DDMS portal within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
 6. No further notice will be given to you in this regard.
